- Women's health focused research
- Sustainability in research

Abstract selection process

All abstracts will be reviewed by a panel who will judge each entry on its relevance to the following areas using a scale of 1-5, where 5 is excellent:

- The relevance to the conference theme of 'Research matters'
- The relevance to research and Health and Care Research Wales who did it, how it came about, who funded it, who was involved.
- The inclusion of public involvement has the public been involved, how has the public been involved (patients, carers, service users etc.)
- The focus of the entry is on one of the called for topics: sustainability, social care research or women's health research
