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Background

- 8 Long standing issue we have listened to feedback from a wide range of people who are affected by this
- 8 Complex processes in place for reimbursement for time, causing great frustration.
- 8 Inability to provide suitable and timely payment for public contributors;
 - 8 Undermines the ability for research to effectively involve the public
 - 8 Excludes certain parts of society from getting involved
 - 8 Wastes research funding



8 Wales triggered a UK wide discussion on this issue about a year ago to try to establish what could be done to improve the situation

8 Health and Care Research Wales is leading a project to try to address the situation in partnership with HRA and NIHR Centre for Engagement & Dissemination



Progress update

- 8 Documents have been produced in collaboration with working groups and our interest group:
 - 8 Statement on expectations
 - 8 Guidance document for payment
 - 8 Categorisation document



- 8 First meeting of the payments sub group held on 1st Nov 21 cochaired by Bob McAlister and Reshma Raycoba
- 8 Group will confirm stakeholder mapping and identify networks for communication
- 8 Key messages to be agreed consistently
- 8 HMRC engagement critical and we are currently in discussions about who we work with directly to progress this work



Next steps

- 8 Finalise categorisation document
- 8 Establish conversation with HMRC about updating guidance to reflect where people/ organisations could benefit from a bit more clarity
- 8 Open dialogue with key stakeholders to support organisations in recognising and committing to rectify the issues; supporting those working with this day to day
