Health and Care Research Wales awards and grants are awarded after a fair and open process, based on merit in accordance with our published criteria. By completing this diversity monitoring form you will be helping us meet our public sector equality duty under section 149 of the Equality Act 2012 and section 75 of the Northern Ireland Act 1998.

Your responses to questions will never be made available to the Board/Panel considering your application. Your personal data will always be treated in confidence and when anonymised with data from other applicants will help us monitor the diversity of the field of applicants, and the success rate of applications by protected characteristic. The summary data may be published by Health and Care Research Wales in a report. We will always ensure that it is not possible to identify individuals from the summary data.

Although it is mandatory to answer these questions, it is possible to select "prefer not to say" as a response. However, the more information you provide, the more effective our monitoring will be. This information will not be used to make decisions about your funding application.
